comments: When considering the use of wireless connections using radio frequencies in the UHF band please consider the requirements of radio microphone users. Bandwidth needs to be preserved to allow the use of wireless microphones for film and television production, stage entertainment, sports events, churches, audio-visual presentations and more.

The introduction of digital terrestrial television has already consumed bandwidth previously available to wireless microphone users. Other initiatives such as wireless broadband threaten to use more.
